

## Codes and Standards

As of the spring of 2018, new projects designed and constructed for the University of Alabama will be required to comply with the following standards, codes and authorities having jurisdiction (AHJ).

### City of Tuscaloosa

- A. The University of Alabama is under the jurisdiction of the City of Tuscaloosa. The codes currently adopted by the City of Tuscaloosa are:

  - 8. National Electrical Code 2014 with local amendments
